From the President


I really enjoy teaching and the designer, Krista Moser, has given me permission to teach one of her patterns in a class. I would like to get an idea of the interest of the group. Below, you will see the two patterns to choose from. A majority of participants will decide which one. Her only requirement is that each person must purchase the pattern (\$ 12.00 each as printed copy or as PDF download). The pattern also recommends a 60-degree ruler. You don't need her ruler. You probably already have one. I have several, various 60-degree rulers.

I would plan to teach the class in June or July. Probably on a Saturday from 10 am – 3 pm.

I am charging just \$10.00 for you to take the class. I will ask at the next 2 meetings who is interested.

To get more info on Krista and her quilts (she does almost exclusively triangles and hexagons (60 degrees) These pieces are large and her instructions are very good. An experienced beginner could manage it. If you have never worked with 60-degree triangles, this is a good one to get your feet wet.



DID YOU KNOW?

Janome means "snake's eye" in Japanese and derives from the appearance of the bobbin design.

Bernina's namesake is the Piz Bernina, the highest summit in the eastern Alps.

Brother's history began in 1908 when it was originally called Yasui Sewing Machine Co in Nagoya, Japan. The company name derives from an early sewing machine model, the Brother, which itself was named for the Yasui brothers, Masayoshi and Jitsuichi.

Baby Lock overlock sewing machines are manufactured by Suzuki machinery Co., Ltd. in Yamagata, Japan. Industrial machines are quite big so scaling it down made it a "baby" version of an "overlocker."

Singer sewing machines are named for American inventor Isaac Merrit Singer. Singer created a machine very similar to other inventors in 1851.

Husqvarna sewing machine was made by a company based in Huskvarna, Sweden.
