Hatchet Block Quilt Together -- Baby Quilts approx 36 "x40", up to 48 "x48"
The Hatchet block is very simple, a square with triangle corners. For this challenge, we are making a baby quilt using the hatchet block. These quilts will be collected (finished) at the July meeting, and donated to the Children's Resource Center for their parent education classes. These are usually used as floor quilts, so use bright colors with lots of contrast.

You can use any size squares, with your choice of corner square sizes. Play around with the layout, sashing, borders, anything you would like to change up.
